He studied music at the Conservatory of Castellón, the Conservatory of Music of Valencia and the Royal Conservatory of Music of Madrid.

In the 1984-85 academic year he completed his higher education on clarinet with the highest qualification, obtaining the End of Degree Honor Award from the Valencia Superior Conservatory of Music.

Likewise, he is in possession of the following qualifications:

- Title of Superior Professor of Harmony, Counterpoint, Composition and Instrumentation.
- Title of Higher Professor of Music Solfeggio, Music Theory, Singing and Accompaniment.

- Higher Degree in Orchestra Direction.

He is an Honorary Prize in Counterpoint and Fugue and an Honorable Mention in Composition from the Superior Conservatory of Music of Valencia.

In his activity as a clarinetist, chamber music predominates, having performed numerous concerts with the Valencia Clarinet Quartet, with which he won Second Prize in the Permanent Competition of Musical Youths of Spain in the specialty of Chamber Music.

From 1981 to 1989 he was a member of the Municipal Band of Castellón. He is an official of the Body of Music and Performing Arts Teachers specializing in Fundamentals of Composition, developing his teaching activity as Head of Department at the Professional Music Conservatory "Mestre Tàrraga" in Castellón.

Since 2018 he is the Artistic Director of the International Guitar Contest "Francisco Tàrraga" of Benicàssim.
